Strength

Challenges

2. Due to limited Faculty, there is no scope to start Honours/DSC courses.
3. Most of students come from Bengali medium who fail to cope up with the English medium of instruction. The majority of the students are first generation learners.
4. Due to humble family background early marriage number of drop-outs is a challenge for the college as a whole.
