OVER VIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT

The department of philosophy was established in the year 2000 with due permission from the Assam University Silchar and got temporary affiliation in 2004_05 from the Assam University Silchar. The department is purely a non-sanctioned department. There is no sanctioned post teacher in this department.

Mr. S. Debhari Singha joined the department in the year 2000 as founder teacher and since then he has been working against the non-sanctioned post till date.

The courses offered by the department are:

Three years degree program, CBCS (Pass course only), affiliated to Assam University Silchar. With the implementation of NEP 2020, the college started FYUG programme from 2023-24 in which philosophy is one of the subjects incorporated as DSM with 30 students as well as IDC with 25 students.

There is scope to offer philosophy as Discipline Specific Core (DSC) from the next session.

TDC 3rd Sem, DSC2/GE=11,

TDC 5th Sem DSE=20/GE=40

Presently the Department has 13 students

2. To make students aware of the present philosophical base.

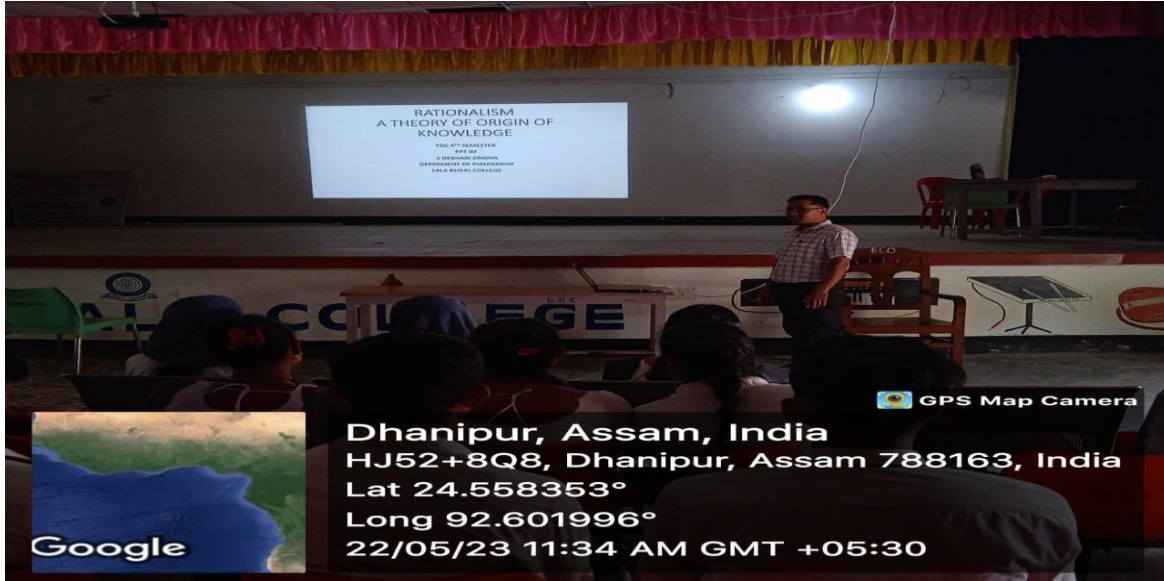
CHALLENGES : It becomes a real challenge to run the department with limited faculty.
