Sub: Institutional policy measures towards making the campus drug-free.

Ref.: Letter No. E-793142/5 dated 03-06-2026 of the Director of Higher Education, Assam.  
Govt. of Assam eCF No. 789739/4, dtd. 18-05-2026 of the Assam Higher Education Dept.

With reference to the cited letters, herein directions were issued towards formulation & implementation of measures to focus on making HEI's drug free through coordinated efforts. Keeping in view above said directions, Lala Rural College, Lala has formulated its Institutional Policy Measures and constituted an Anti-Drug Committee towards making the campus drug-free.

### INSTITUTIONAL POLICY MEASURES TOWARDS MAKING THE CAMPUS DRUG-FREE.

Creating drug-free campus requires a multi-pronged approach encompassing strict policy formulation, continuous campus awareness, robust student support, regular surveillance, and rehabilitation support. With this end, Lala Rural College, Lala has formulated the following Institutional Policy Measures:

#### **Institutional Policy and Regulatory Framework:**

- a) **Anti-Drug Declarations:** All incoming and existing students, along with their parents, require to sign a mandatory undertaking or declaration form during admissions affirming their commitment to keep the campus drug-free and not to use any kind of intoxicating drinks, drugs and other banned substances in the campus or during sponsored events.
- b) **Code of Conduct:** Purchase, possession, use, or distribution of illicit substances on premises and or during sponsored events such as field trips, study tour, excursion, picnic.
- c) **Disciplinary Procedures:** The use, possession, sale, and distribution of drugs in the campus will not be tolerated. College follows a zero-tolerance policy with clearly outlined disciplinary consequences - such as mandatory counseling, parental notification, probation, suspension or outright expulsion/termination for habitual offenders or other penalties as decided by the institution.
- d) **Institutional Committee:** Dedicated Anti-Drug Committee comprising faculty, student & non-teaching staff representatives (covering NSS, Disciplinary Committee, Student Welfare Committee and Anti-Ragging Committee members).
- e) **Regulatory Compliance:** Designated Member Coordinator of Anti-Drug Committee to oversee and report on all campus prevention activities on a quarterly basis.

- Partner with the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and local police for reporting drug peddling and conducting routine checks. The Committee shall intimate the higher authority, if anyone is found or reasonable believed to be indulging in consumption or possession or sale of purchase of Narcotic and Psychotropic drugs.

## 2. Awareness & Education:

- Integrate educational content on the dangers of substance abuse into the curriculum. Utilize the UGC's "Drugs of Abuse" course on the SWAYAM Platform.
- Organize workshops, rallies, street plays, and documentary screenings with the help of student groups like the NCC, NSS, and distribute Information Education and Communication (IEC) materials available via the Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan Portal.
- Prominently display anti-drug hoardings across campuses outlining the legal and disciplinary consequences of drug use, including the 100-yard tobacco and drug-free zone prohibition.
- Make arrangements for observing World No Tobacco Day on 31<sup>st</sup> May and International Day against Drug Abuse and illicit trafficking on 26<sup>th</sup> June every year.
- Engage students in Anti-Drug activities and educate them about the ill-effects.

## 3. Counseling & Rehabilitation

- Set up confidential, non-judgmental counseling facilities within campus to help students deal with academic stress and peer pressure.
- Train student volunteers to act as positive role models and peer mentors who can identify and report behavioral changes early on.
- Develop supportive re-entry and rehabilitation plans for students returning from treatment, focusing on continued mentorship and monitoring.

The committee is functional with immediate effect and remains effective till further order.


